Wahconah Building Project Update



Town Vote – Saturday April 6th

The Wahconah Feasibility Study is reaching the final stages of completion and the town votes for the project have been scheduled for Saturday April 6th. Another set of community meetings have been scheduled to help the public become informed about the design, budget, timeline, and impact to town taxes prior to the vote. The times and locations of the meetings are located in the right side column. The agenda for each meeting will include:

- Design overview that includes floor plans, materials, external views, locations of athletic field, and parking
- Budget of the project that will include an estimate of the MSBA's contribution
- Timeline for construction
- Impact on local property taxes

At the last WBC meeting the committee voted to explore using a geothermal system as the primary heating and cooling system for the building. This will mean that no fossil fuels will be burned to heat the building. Some solar panels will be placed in the roof to help offset electrical usage. Having a geothermal system and solar panels will help to make the building more energy independent as we move into the future.
